

Summary of the Newness of the New Covenant – Hebrews 8:10-12

10For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the Lord

- Internalised Law - Written on the Heart and Mind

I will put my laws into their minds, and write them on their hearts,

- Belonging - New Covenant People Belong to God and He to Them (eternally, spiritually).

and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

- Know God - Intimately, Personally and Savingly

11And they shall not teach, each one his neighbor and each one his brother, saying, 'Know the Lord,' for they shall all know me, from the least of them to the greatest.

- Receive Eternal Mercy and Forgiveness - Sin Problem Solved Permanently

12For I will be merciful toward their iniquities, and I will remember their sins no more.
